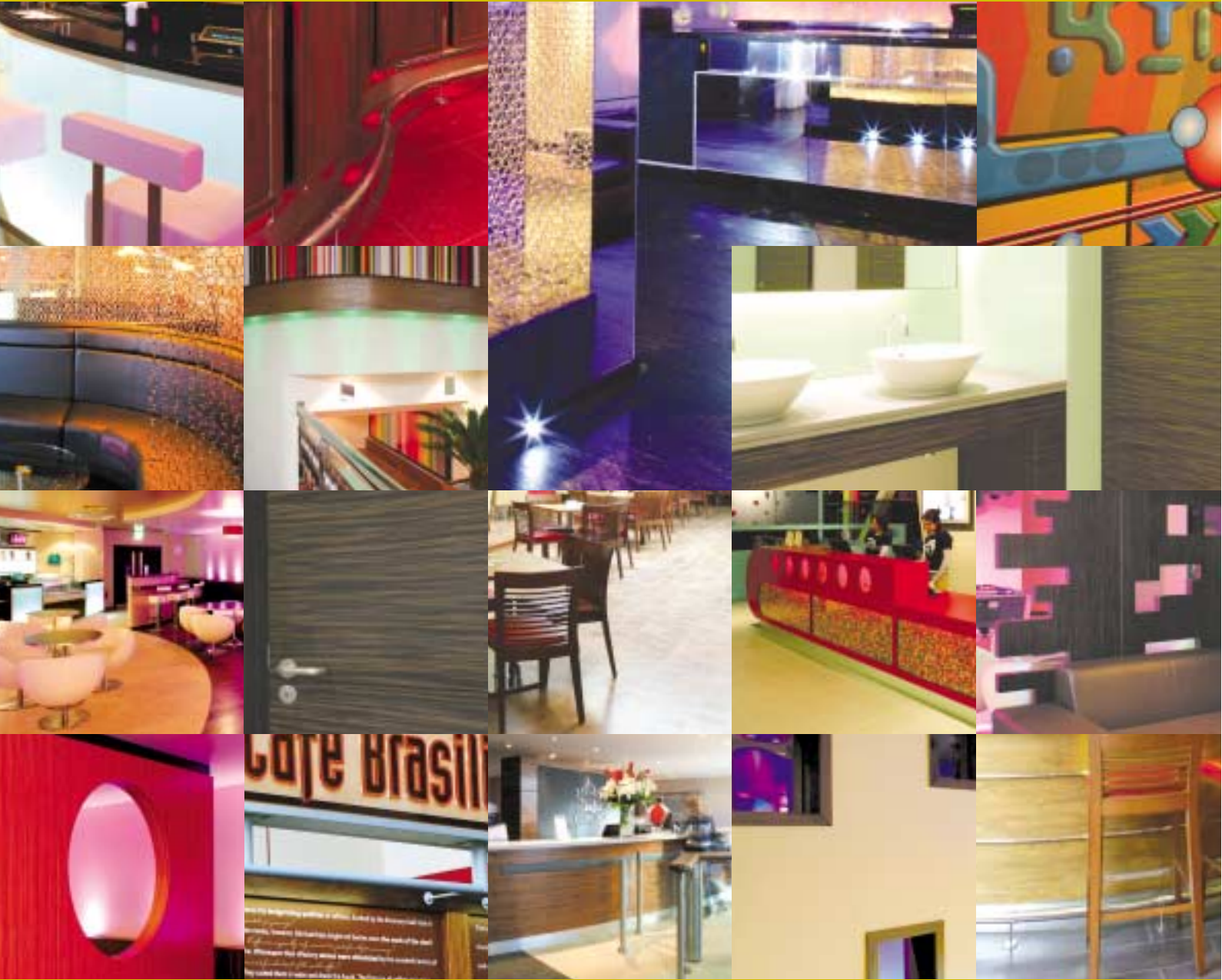

To ensure minimum disruption to arguably the most prestigious nightclub in the UK, Washroom Joinery provided a seven days-a-week service resulting in just four weeks turnaround from commencement of manufacturing to completion of installation.

The project included the design and manufacture of two granite topped bars incorporating feature lighting and toughened mirror faces, back bars, fire door sets, an upholstered DJ booth and leather seating.

Brought in at the early design stages, Washroom Joinery value engineered the project to meet the client's budget without compromise to the integrity of the design.



Gallery Bar, Hendon

Client: Kelly Leisure Main Contractor: Quinn London Ltd / Idiom Design

Designed to bring the sophistication of the 'West End' to north London, Gallery is a £4million entertainment venue comprised of a first class restaurant, contemporary bar and nightclub.



Working with the specialist designers Idiom, the Joinery division of Washroom Washroom produced the high quality finish required for the 120-seat bar. Additionally close co-operation with the lighting specialists provided the dramatic LED mood lighting around the bar area.

To complete the effect materials such as natural veneers and laminates, stainless steel and solid walnut were cut using 3D laser technology and integrated with specialist glazing.

The restaurant, in contrast to the entertainment areas, features traditional full panelling and a theatre kitchen framed by brass, walnut and granite. A curved and panelled wall conceals cloak cupboards by imitating a library of classically bound volumes.

The nightclub features modern 3D artworks and again specialised mood lighting was installed and when combined with the high quality joinery fittings, provides the unique and sophisticated atmosphere that matches the client's brief exactly.

Kidspace, London

Kidspace, the 40,000-sqft children's activity area, situated within the Brewery Retail Park provides a totally new concept in the provision of children's entertainment.

Working closely with the client and main contractor to meet the tight deadline and the stringent health and safety requirements associated with a project of this type, Washroom Joinery manufactured every item of joinery to the highest standards.

The contract included the reception counter incorporating in excess of 10,000 coloured feature marbles underlit for maximum effect, unique shaped walls in the locker area, bold graphics, bar and counter. Other elements comprised point of sale, tables and seating in the café together with upholstered seating, shaped tables and chairs as well as feature entrances and walls to the party rooms.





Student Union Bar, Westminster

Client: Westminster University Main Contractor: KLC



To meet the budgetary requirements of this unique and striking bar concept, Washroom Joinery worked closely with the main contractor to value engineer detail without losing the integrity of the design.

To keep within budget, the bar, originally designed as a glass curve on plan, was manufactured faceted, without any compromise to the concept. Back and front accent lighting provided an added dimension, finished with a highly durable granite counter top.

Other features include lighting troughs with printed glass screens, wall panelling, the delicatessen bar, curved wall cappings and walnut veneer feature light boxes.

Fire rated back projection windows were installed within the curved seating booths, which were manufactured on-site for precision of installation.



Café Brasilia, Keighley

Client: Café Brasilia Main Contractor: Washroom Joinery

Working directly for the client, the complete project was designed, manufactured and built off-site to enable fast installation in the live environment of a busy shopping centre.

Installation was undertaken where possible during closing hours to minimise disruption to shoppers, where this was not feasible our dedicated contracts manager ensured rigorous adherence to Health & Safety.

The project included acrylic back lit lightboxes, screen printed menu boards, veneers and laminates combined with Corian feature edging to the counter tops, glass and stainless steel balustrading, curved glass screens, seating and tables.



Block 3, Brighton

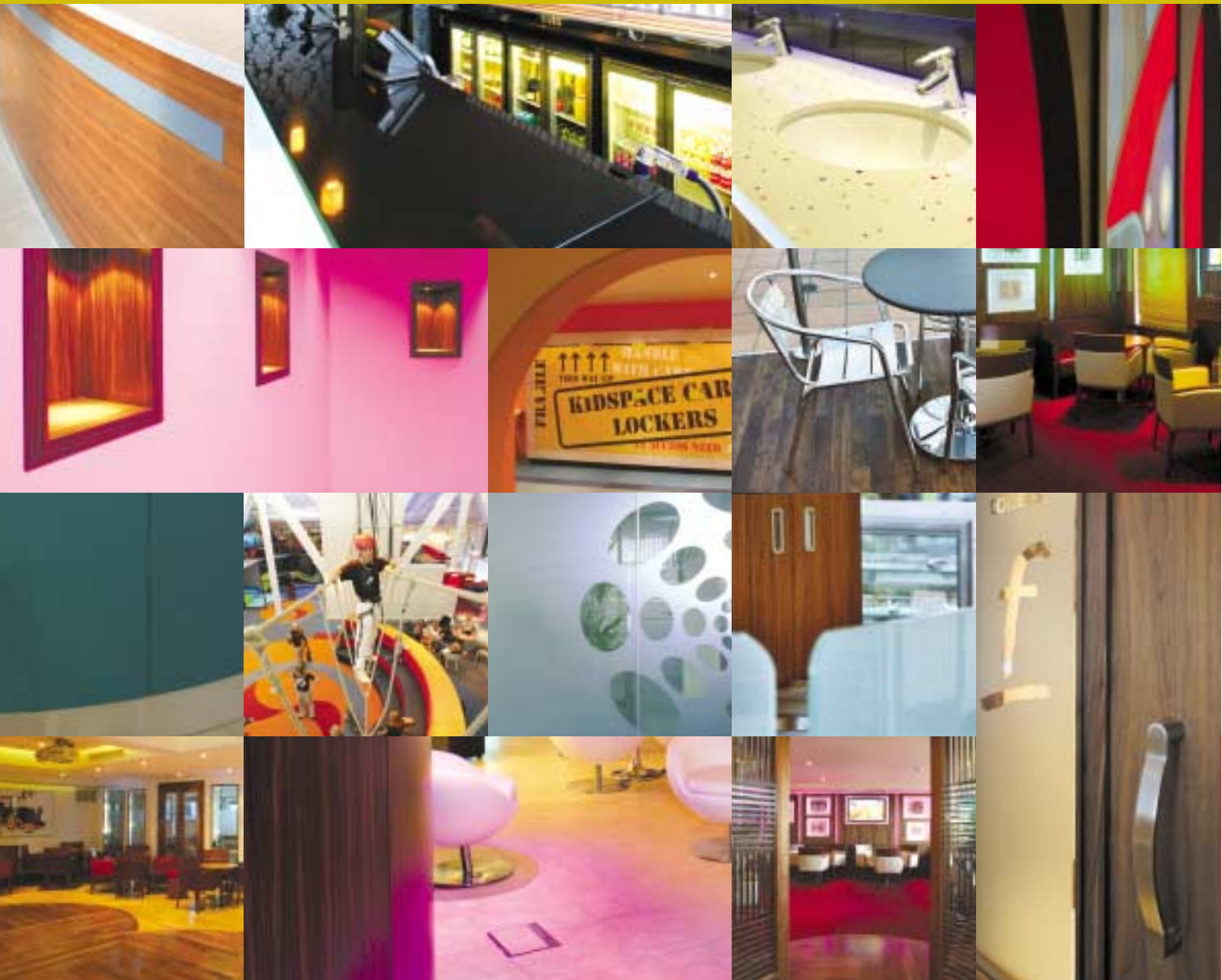
Client: Larrik Property Limited Main Contractor: Rok Build Limited

This high specification office building in the heart of Brighton's rapidly developing commercial district, incorporates bespoke, full-height Alto washroom cubicles and contrasting glass wall linings with natural stone vanity tops.

The project was one of the first where the real wood veneer was laid horizontally as a design feature.

Washroom Joinery undertook the manufacture and installation of all the internal doors and frames together with feature glass wall linings to the lift lobby.
